Job Title: Midday Supervisor

Accountable To: Head Teacher/Deputy Head Teacher and SENDCo

Main Purpose:

To provide daily care, support and a safe play environment for pupils inside or external to a school environment by maintaining discipline and good behaviour.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Ensure the hall is ready for all students requiring facilities during lunchtime.
- Encourage appropriate eating in the dining hall and to ensure the room is cleared and ready for school use in the afternoon by wiping down tables and clearing any spillages.
- Supervise and ensure students are well behaved on the premises at all times. Where student conflicts arise deal with in the appropriate manner following the school's behaviour policy.
- Be aware of any relevant policies relating to student behaviour.
- Understand the appropriate course of action in case of personal injury to students.
- Challenge unauthorised entry to school premises reporting to a senior member of staff.
- Undertake other responsibilities appropriate to the level of the post.
- Work within the school's policies and procedure.
- Maintain discipline within the hall, classrooms (wet play) and on the playground.
- Operate consistently to all students.
- Make appropriate decisions about outside play when there is inclement weather.
- Interact with children to support play.

Where a current First Aid qualification is held, in the absence of other medical facilities:

- Maintain First Aid equipment and materials, and dispense medicines in accordance with school policy.
- Undertake First Aid and support children with identified medical needs as appropriate.
- Record accidents and injuries in line with the school's policy.

Training:

• Attend statutory training courses as required for the post; Safeguarding and Child Protection, PREVENT and First Aid.

Safeguarding:

- Recognise the moral and statutory responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of children
- Provide a welcoming and safe environment where children are valued and respected
- Be alert to the signs of abuse and neglect and follow our procedures and policies to ensure children receive effective support, protection and guidance
